Supreme Ritualist	Any Active New Mexico Rainbow Girl. The girls can compete in this category as well As an additional category.	Bow Grab Bag	Contestants will randomly draw a bow station from a bag. They will be allowed two tries.
Grand Ritualist	All Past Worthy Advisors, Worthy Advisors, Worthy Associate Advisors, and Sisters of Charity, as of the Spring Term 2010, should compete here, unless initiated after 07/01/09	Charity	Charity's Initiation Lecture
