Brianna's special service project is the *American Cancer Society*.

The Ronald McDonald House Charities of NM is located in Albuquerque but provides a home for families from across our state with ill or injured children being cared for at an Albuquerque medical facility. The Ronald McDonald house has 30 bedrooms. They average about 70 "guests" per night. Providing their "guests" with a dinner meal is included in the nominal cost of their stay.

The Ronald McDonald House is located on UNM's North Campus close to UNMH. Right next door is *Casa Esparanza* which began as a vision of the UNM Cancer Center Board of Advisors and the Realtor Assn. of NM 20+ years ago. It is also a non-profit home to house families who are referred to Albuquerque for their loved one's cancer treatment. It can accommodate 28 families for both long and short term stays.

Given our large numbers, some will volunteer at the Ronald McDonald House, while others are at Casa Esparanza. Of course as *volunteers* we might do projects such as light cleaning - indoors or out - sanitizing toys - organizing books and puzzles - preparing their dinner meal (they have a fabulous kitchen facility!), folding linens, reading to or playing on the playground with young siblings of the children who are in Albuquerque for treatment, They will find plenty for us to do in the time that we will be there!
